Pricing Structure & Additional Cost

SDA's tuition pricing is inclusive of the following:

- Registration Fees
- Base level weekly technical instruction
- Rehearsal and costume rental for production

Rehearsal time for the spring production is estimated to be 4-8 hours of additional class time during the spring semester, depending on role. Soloist or leads may need to be available for additional times.

Additional options may become available such as specialized workshops & intensives, as well as competition-related rehearsal lessons & entry fees. These electives are all in addition to the base tuition, and estimates will attempt to be provided at least 60 days in advance.

Location

Until SDA's permanent studio space is finished, classes will be held at 50 E Cherry St, Sunbury, OH (Linda's). Available is a 1600 sq ft, sprung, hardwood floor. Barre's will be provided.

Payment Policies

Tuition can be split into equal monthly payments over 9 months, due on the 1st of the month (except for the first month of the semester which is due by the first day of classes).

Payments more than 15 days late may incur a \$25 late charge. Payments more than 30 days late may result in student being withheld classes.

We accept all major credit cards, bank transfers, & checks. Auto-withdraw may be set up.

A non-sufficient funds fee of \$35 will be applied for returned checks.

Discounts

Pay the tuition in full by the first day of classes to receive a 5% discount. Payment must be made by check. Electives are eligible for this discount.

Each additional sibling will receive a 10% discount off the lower-level student's tuition.

Electives and additional options (specialized elective workshops, intensives, or competition related expenses) are not eligible for this discount.

Refer a new student who enrolls and both (referrer & referee) receive a \$25 bill credit after first monthly payment is made.

Class Attendance, Make-Up, and Cancellations

Regular attendance is encouraged. Notify the Artistic Director at least 24 hours in advance for absences. No refunds will be given for missing group classes. If available, a student may be able to attend a similar level class.

If classes must be cancelled due to inclement weather, every effort will be made for them to be rescheduled.

Tuition is non-refundable except for studio-initiated cancellations (ie: instructor absence, facility closure). Refunds will be made as a studio credit.

If a student wishes to withdraw from classes, please notify the studio in writing at least 14 days prior to next bill due date, along with students expected last day of classes. No refunds will be given for mid-billing cycle withdrawals.

Spring Production

May 22 & 23, 2026 will be SDA's production of *Alice In Wonderland* at the beautiful Knox Memorial Theater. While not mandatory for Prep Level dancers, every student is strongly encouraged to participate as choreography elements will be part of their curriculum. Participation is mandatory for Academy Level students.

Students will have to provide their own footwear, tights, and/or other general dancewear, possibly in specific colors. Outer costumes will be provided by SDA.

Show fee and/or tickets are TBD. In 2025, SDA had a ticket fee of \$120 per family which included: 6 tickets, commemorative T-shirt, souvenir programs, and a digital recording.

Semester Calendar & Rates

SDA tuition is calculated based on the number of instructional weeks 35 week per season. The Academy will be open Mon & Tues of both Thanksgiving & Christmas week, closed between Christmas and New Years, and closed during BWSD Spring Break week.
