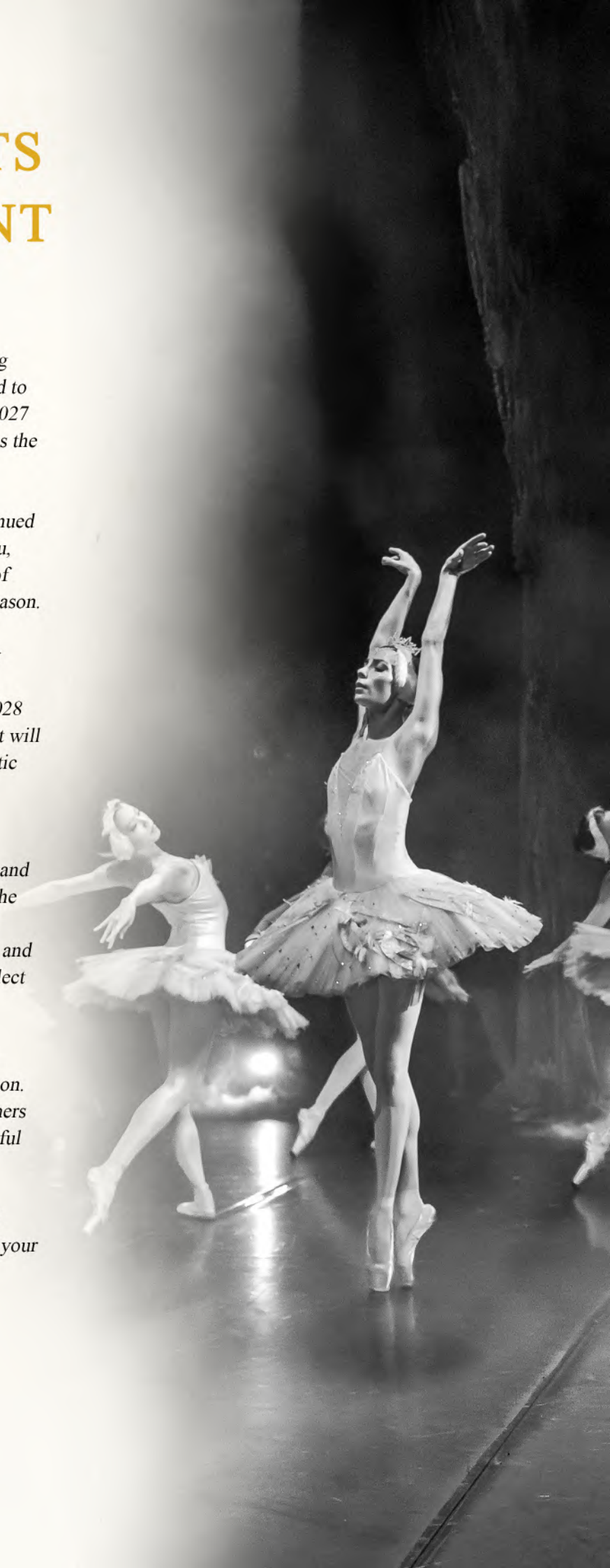

SYNOPSIS



ACT I

A HEART PURE AS SNOW

ACT I

SCENE 1. The Mirror and the Stepmother.

In a faraway kingdom lived a beautiful young princess named Snow White. After the death of the King and Queen, she was left all alone. Her cruel stepmother seized power, took away Snow White's golden crown, and forced her to do the hardest household work.

One morning, Snow White was cleaning the palace with her friends when the sound of trumpets filled the halls. A Prince from a neighboring kingdom had arrived at the royal court. The handsome Prince instantly fell in love with Snow White, enchanted by her beauty and kindness. Consumed by jealousy, the Queen rushed to her magic mirror and demanded: «Mirror, mirror, who is the fairest of them all?» The mirror named Snow White. Furious with rage, the Queen ordered the huntsman to take Snow White deep into the forest and kill her.

SCENE 2. Betrayal.

However, the huntsman could not carry out the cruel order. Feeling pity for Snow White, he led her far into the forest and left her there unharmed.

SCENE 3. The Enchanted Forest.

Alone in the dark forest, Snow White is overcome with fear and despair. The shadows of the trees seem frightening, and the sounds of the night forest appear ominous. Soon, however, the forest comes alive with warmth and kindness. Rabbits, squirrels, foxes, and other magical woodland creatures gather around her. They help Snow White discover a small cozy cottage hidden among the trees. Inside, the house is in complete disorder, as though no one had ever cleaned it. Together with her forest friends, Snow White quickly brings warmth and comfort to the cottage before falling asleep from exhaustion.

SCENE 4. The Seven Dwarfs

The owners of the cottage - seven hardworking and cheerful dwarfs - return home. At first, they are surprised to find an unexpected guest, but Snow White's sincerity and kindness quickly win their hearts. The dwarfs welcome her into their joyful world, while Snow White brings warmth, care, and happiness into their home. A true friendship is born between them.

SCENE 5. The Queen's New Plan

Certain of her victory, the Queen once again turns to the magic mirror. But the mirror still names Snow White as the fairest in the land. Realizing that the girl is alive, the Queen is filled with fury. Disguising herself as an old woman, she prepares a cunning new plan - a poisoned apple capable of casting Snow White into an eternal sleep.

SCENE 6. The Poisoned Apple

One bright morning, Snow White busily prepares breakfast for the dwarfs. Thanks to her, the little men are slowly becoming accustomed to cleanliness, order, and morning exercises. After the dwarfs leave for work in the mine, Snow White remains alone in the cottage. Disguised as a kind old woman, the Queen appears and offers her a magical apple. The moment Snow White takes a bite, the evil spell takes effect, and she collapses lifeless to the ground. The Queen triumphs in her cruel victory.

SCENE 7. Grief of the Friends

Returning home, the dwarfs find Snow White motionless. Forest animals and friends gather around her as sadness and silence fill the cottage. Even the cheerful dwarfs lose hope, unable to accept the loss of the one who brought light and joy into their lives.

SCENE 8. The Triumph of Love

The Prince, who has been searching for Snow White all this time, finally arrives. Saying farewell to his beloved, he gently kisses her - and at that very moment, a miracle happens: the evil spell is broken, and Snow White awakens. Love conquers evil. Stripped of her magical powers, the Queen is banished from the kingdom forever, while the people celebrate kind Snow White and the brave Prince.



BOGDAN PAWŁOWSKI

- BOGDAN PAWŁOWSKI -

Bogdan Pawłowski was a Polish composer, conductor and pianist, one of the most distinguished figures in 20th-century Polish music.

He was born on October 10, 1915 in Warsaw. He studied composition with Kazimierz Sikorski at the Warsaw Conservatory and later continued his education in Paris with Nadia Boulanger, one of the most influential teachers of the time.

Pawłowski's music combines lyrical expressiveness, clarity of form and a refined sense of harmony.

He drew inspiration from Polish folk music, neoclassical elegance and European musical traditions.

He composed ballets, operas, symphonic poems, concertos, chamber music and songs. His works have been performed in Poland and around the world, appreciated for their emotional depth, poetic beauty and theatrical flair.

One of his most beloved creations is the ballet Snow White (Królewna Śnieżka), composed in 1962. The score brings the fairy tale to life with vivid characters,

colorful orchestration and a magical atmosphere that enchants both children and adults.

Pawłowski was closely connected with the Warsaw Grand Theatre, serving as music director and chief conductor for many years. He was also a respected teacher, educating generations of young composers and musicians.

His works have been recognized with numerous awards, including the State Prize of the 1st degree and the Gold Cross of Merit.

Bogdan Pawłowski passed away on August 23, 1994 in Warsaw, leaving behind a rich and enduring legacy.

Trained at the National College of Choreography in Chişinău under renowned ballet teacher Andrey Litvinov, Sergei Zdanschi began his professional career with the National Opera and Ballet Theatre of Moldova while still a student, quickly gaining recognition for his strong technique and expressive stage presence.

He later performed as a Leading Ballet Soloist in Dnipro, Ukraine, where he debuted as Prince Siegfried in Swan Lake, establishing himself as a promising classical dancer.

Sergei has toured internationally across Europe and Asia, appearing on stages in France, Germany, Italy, Spain, Switzerland, Sweden, and China. His repertoire includes leading roles in Swan Lake, The Nutcracker, The Sleeping Beauty, and other classical ballets.

Today, Sergei Zdanschi performs as a Principal Dancer with Classical Arts Entertainment.

BAITLER**

Trained at the Dnepropetrovsk Theater and Art College and the Dnepropetrovsk School of Classical Dance, Ilona Baitler quickly gained recognition for her strong classical technique, musicality, and expressive stage presence.

In 2020, she joined Classical Arts Entertainment, becoming one of the company's leading artists and performing extensively across Europe, including France, Germany, Switzerland, and Poland. Her repertoire includes principal and soloist roles such as Odette/Odile in Swan Lake, Aurora in The Sleeping Beauty, Cinderella in Cinderella, Clara in The Nutcracker, Kitri in Don Quixote, and Mavka in The Forest Song.

Ilona is also a prize winner of several international ballet competitions in Ukraine. Today, she performs internationally as a Principal Dancer, captivating audiences with her elegance, refined technique, and dramatic interpretation of classical roles.



**KANAT
NADURBEK**

Trained at the Bishkek Choreographic School under renowned teacher Uran Sarbagyshev, Kanat Nadurbek Uulu began his professional career with the Kyrgyz National Opera and Ballet Theatre named after Abdylas Malydybaev.

Early in his career, he toured extensively across Europe and Asia, performing in nearly forty countries, and later worked with Universal Ballet in Seoul, South Korea.

In 2016, Kanat joined the Primorsky Stage of the Mariinsky Theatre in Vladivostok as a soloist and was promoted to Principal Dancer in 2018, becoming the first Kyrgyz dancer in history to achieve this rank at the Mariinsky Theatre.

His repertoire includes leading roles in Swan Lake, Giselle, The Sleeping Beauty, Romeo and Juliet, and Le Corsaire. In 2019, he was awarded the honorary title of Honored Artist of the Kyrgyz Republic.



**RAVSHAN KYZY
SUIUMKAN**

Ravshan Kyzy Suiumkan is an internationally active classical ballet dancer recognized for her expressive stage presence, refined technique, and versatility across both lyrical and virtuoso repertoire.

She received her professional ballet training in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan, specializing in classical technique, pointe work, and pas de deux. Following her graduation, she performed internationally with touring ballet companies across Europe and the United Kingdom.

Her repertoire includes principal roles in Swan Lake, The Sleeping Beauty, The Nutcracker, and Cinderella.

Ravshan has appeared in numerous international ballet productions and festivals and is the recipient of awards from competitions in Kyrgyzstan, Kazakhstan, Germany, and France. Today, she continues to perform internationally as a principal and soloist artist.



**DIANA
STETSENKO**

Beginning her ballet training at the age of seven in Kyiv, the Ukrainian ballerina later graduated from the Kyiv State Choreographic School in 2019 and began her professional career with the Lviv National Opera before joining the National Opera of Ukraine.

In 2022, she received a contract with Semperoper Dresden in Germany, and since 2023 has performed as a leading dancer with the Grand Kyiv Ballet. In 2025, she joined the ballet troupe of Classical Arts Entertainment.

A finalist and prizewinner of international ballet competitions in Kyiv, she has toured extensively across Europe, Australia, New Zealand, and the United States, performing a wide range of classical repertoire. Her repertoire includes leading and soloist roles in Swan Lake, The Nutcracker, Sleeping Beauty, Giselle, Don Quixote, The Snow Queen, and Forest Song, demonstrating both lyrical artistry and strong classical technique.

Since 2018 until present time, The United European Ballet Company has been working on engaging the studios all over the country with the **I Love to Dance Program**.

The Program has grown into a 30+ Partner Studios that perform throughout the East Coast Tour every year. Classical Arts Entertainment casts student dancers ages 5-18 in ancillary roles performing alongside the professional ballet dancers. A wide variety of parts for young dancers is offered during the Grand National Tour 2026/2027, in such repertoire, as: Classical arts entertainment I Love to Dance Program Director and Producer, Michael Art, plays a central role in supporting and developing young dancers who share the stage with professional artists in productions including **The Nutcracker, Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs, Cinderella, Sleeping Beauty, and Swan Lake.**

Under his direction and creative leadership, **I Love to Dance** partner studios audition and rehearse thousands of local ballet students in tour cities each season. During the 2026 to 2027 Winter and Spring tours across the United States, more than 5000 students are expected to participate, gaining meaningful stage experience and professional-level preparation.

The **I Love to Dance** program is designed to prepare young performers for confident, high-quality appearances alongside an international company of professional ballet artists, offering practical production experience, artistic growth, and memorable opportunities on major theater stages.
